## 3.0 Emerging Issues.

- 1. Raise public awareness regarding the boundaries of Nyamira Municipality.
- 2. Initiate the construction of a police post at Miruka Market, utilizing available land, to ensure security for traders.
- 3. Add more street lights within the market area to promote extended trading hours.
- 4. Facilitate the opening of backstreets to increase trading opportunities and activities.
- 5. Educate the public on municipal by-laws through community barazas, specifically organized by local chiefs.
- 6. Acquire suitable land for use by goat traders within Miruka market.
- 7. Allocate designated areas for various traders, including boda boda and tomato vendors and ensure the traders use those areas.
- 8. Enhance efficient enforcement mechanisms to maximize revenue collection from all stakeholders.
- 9. The Municipality is to hold elections for the Miruka Market Committee members.
- 10. The municipality spatial map is to be made available for members of the public.
- 11. Construct a perimeter fence around the market shed to enable traders to have security for their goods.


